Diamond - wreath of diamonds like wings on your shoulder

Circular needles 3.5 mm (US 4) 40 and 80 cm

Circular needles 3 mm (US 2.5) 40 and 80 cm

Double pointed needles 3 mm and 3.5 mm

7 buttons

Gauge

22 sts and 29 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st using 3.5 mm needles.

Check gauge and adjust needle size if necessary.

Note

Body and sleeves are worked in the round except Seed st borders on body and neckline that are worked back and forth.

Body and sleeves are then joined to work yoke in the round.

Short rows are worked on the back. Round begins and ends with purl stitches for steek at front of the body. The front is cut open after securing the steek.

Seed stitch: *Rnd 1:* Work *k1, p1*, repeat from *-*.

Rnd 2: Purl the k sts, knit the p sts. Repeat rnd 1 and 2.

Body

CO 201, 217, 233, 249, 265, 281, 297 sts with color A using 3 mm circular needle. Work back and forth in Seed st for 8 rows.

Place 6 first and 6 last sts of row on st holder => 189, 205, 221, 237, 253, 269, 285 sts. Change to 3.5 mm circular needle.

CO 4 sts (2 first and 2 last sts of rnd that are purled for steek) and join in the rnd => 193, 209, 225, 241, 257, 273, 289 sts.

Work until body measures 26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38 cm.

Set aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves

CO 44, 46, 48, 50, 52, 54, 56 sts with color A using 3 mm dpn.

Join in the rnd and work Seed st for 8 rnds. Change to 3.5 mm dpn and inc 1 st after first st and 1 st before last st of rnd,

then in every 6th, 6th, 6th, 6th, 5th, 5th, 5th rnd, total 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 times => 76, 80, 84, 88, 92, 96, 100 sts. Work

until sleeve measures 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 48 cm. Place total 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 23 sts at end and beginning of

rnd on st holder => 65, 67, 69, 71, 73, 75, 77 sts.

Work second sleeve.

Yoke

Join body and sleeves with color A using 3.5 mm circular needle. Work right front 44, 47, 50, 53, 56, 59, 62 sts. Place next 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 23 sts of body on st holder for underarm. K first sleeve 65, 67, 69, 71, 73, 75, 77 sts. K 83, 89, 95, 101, 107, 113, 119 sts for back. Place next 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 23 sts of body on st holder for underarm. K second sleeve 65, 67, 69, 71, 73, 75, 77 sts. Work left front 44, 47, 50, 53, 56, 59, 62 sts => 301, 317, 333, 349, 365, 381, 397 sts. Place markers mid sleeves. Work pattern and dec as indicated from **chart**. Change to shorter circular needle when necessary.

Short rows at back: Place markers on both sides of shoulders in line with markers mid sleeve. Work back and forth. When turning, always wrap the yarn around the next stitch that is not knitted to prevent gap.

Work until 6 sts from L-marker at left shoulder, turn. Work back until 6 sts from R-marker at right shoulder, turn.

Work until 3 sts from L-marker, turn. Work back until 3 sts from R-marker, turn.

Work to L-marker, turn. Work back to R-marker, turn.

Work 3 sts further than L-marker, turn. Work 3 sts further than R-marker, turn.

Work to beg of rnd.

When chart is complete => 81, 85, 89, 93, 97, 101, 105 sts.

BO 4 p sts mid front => 77, 81, 85, 89, 93, 97, 101 sts.

Finishing, Bands and Neckband

Graft underarm sts together. Weave in loose ends but pull the ends next to the p st steek to RS between the p sts. Sew with machine using straight small stitches and matching thread twice on both sides through chain of p sts at front, securing the ends at the same time.

Work bands and neckband back and forth.

Left band: From WS, slip 6 sts from st holder to 3 mm needle. With color A, CO 4 sts for facing at inner edge. Work back and forth 6 sts in Seed st as set, 4 sts for facing in St st (k RS, p WS). Work until band, when slightly stretched, reaches the neckline. BO the St sts and place the remaining 6 Seed sts on st holder. Cut between the sewn rows. Sew band and facing aligned in place; sew between band st and facing to knit st edge. Sew facing to WS, hiding the machine stitch.

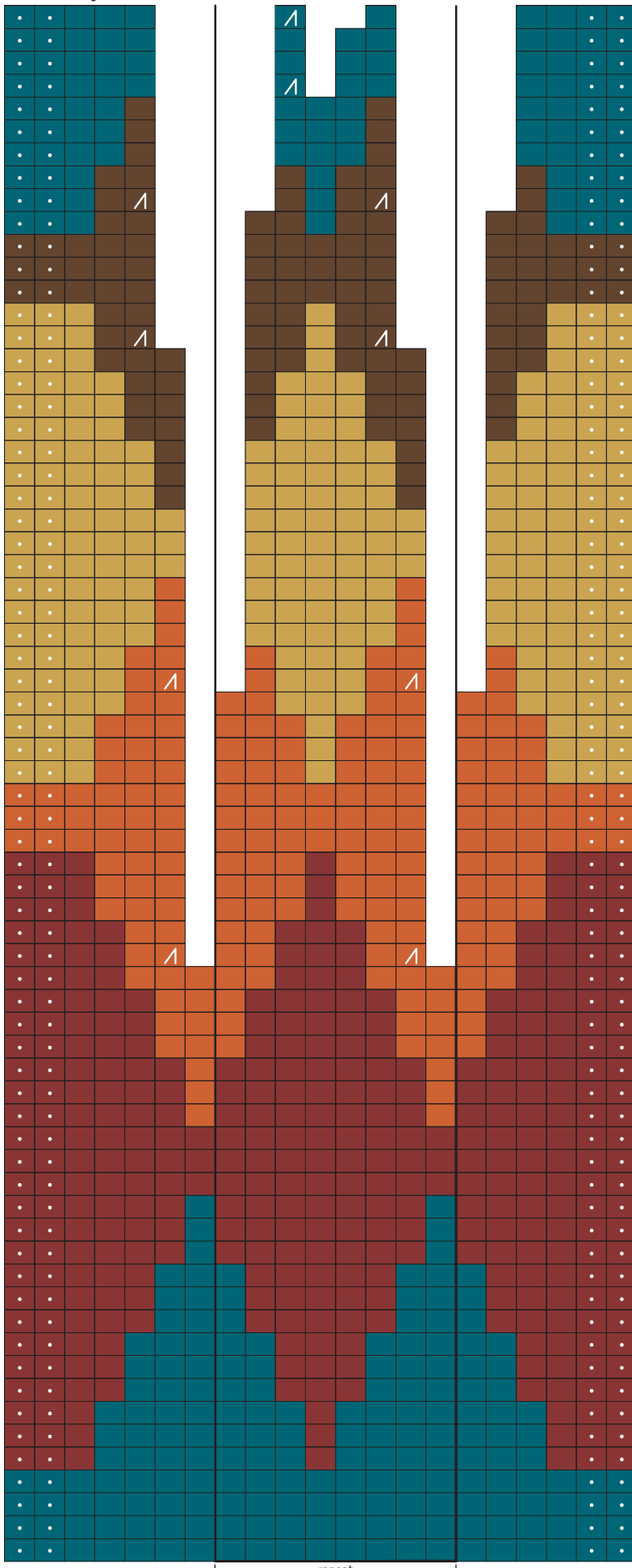
Mark position of 6 buttons, the first button will be at neckband, last above the Seed stitch rib, the others evenly spaced between the two.

Right band: From RS, slip 6 sts from st holder to 3 mm needle and CO 4 sts for facing on left side of sts. Work as left band, but work buttonholes opposite the marks from RS.

Buttonholes: Work 3 sts in Seed st, yo, k2tog, work as set to end of row. Next row: K or p into the yo.

Sew band to front as for left band.

Chart - yoke

Neckband: From RS using 3 mm circular needle, work in Seed st 6 sts from right band, k 1 row and dec evenly spaced 0, 2, 4, 6, 10, 12, 16 sts => 77, 79, 81, 83, 83, 85, 85 sts, work 6 sts in Seed st from left band => 89, 91, 93, 95, 95, 97, 97 sts. Work back and forth 3 rows in Seed st. Next row: Work buttonhole as for band. Work total 8 rows in Seed st. B0 in Seed st and weave in loose ends.

Rinse cardigan by hand in lukewarm water and lay flat to dry in right measurements.

To decorate and break up the pattern sew with color A, C and D three duplicate stitches irregularly between the diamonds (see photo).

Fasten buttons.

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
